SOL Information
With SOL tests quickly approaching, we wanted to share some important information about testing:

## Reminders

Students must arrive to school on time on scheduled testing days.
Students' laptops should be fully charged and they need to bring their charger with them to school.

## Testing Dates

$6^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grade students will take the Reading and Math SOL tests on the following dates:

- Reading SOL-Thursday May $11^{\text {th }}$
- Math SOL- Thursday May $18^{\text {th }}$


## 8th Grade Testing

In addition to the Reading and Math SOL, $8^{\text {th }}$ grade students will take the Civics and Science SOL tests on the following dates:

- Civics SOL-Tuesday May $9^{\text {th }}$
- Science SOL- Tuesday May $16^{\text {th }}$


## Expedited Retakes

If a student scores between 375-399 on any SOL they are eligible for an expedited retake. In order to participate in retakes the attached form must be returned to your student's homeroom teacher by Friday, May 19 ${ }^{\text {th }}$. Expedited retakes will take place on various dates between May $30^{\text {th }}-$ June $8^{\text {th }}$.
